

Pastor's Spiritual Leave

Both Lynne and I, want to thank the SPRC and the entire congregation for offering us our upcoming 4 week spiritual leave. The UNY Conference Time off Policy states, "Full time clergy shall have at least 2 weeks per year of Continuing Education/Spiritual Growth Leave (as per ¶ 351.1 & 351.2). Furthermore, once every quadrennial period (every four years) there should be one year where an additional month of Continuing Education/Spiritual Growth is undertaken. In my 36 years of ministry this is the first (4) week leave I have taken and I feel blessed in doing so.

The spiritual leave will run from Monday, July 18- Sunday, August 14th. During this time, Pastor Sean will handle the day to day responsibilities along with Gretchen Burlison and Dave Alexander. Members of the SPRC will also be available to assist, if needed. You will also be blessed in worship as selected brothers and sisters will offer their faith witness that will certainly inspire and connect us. Steve Johnson, Ken Anderson, Anita VanWinkle, and Jody Butts will all be sharing their faith journey as Howard Champlain, Jim Short and Dave Alexander will lead worship during my time away.

Dear parents,

As I take some time to be in discernment during my 4-week spiritual leave, please keep children and youth ministries in your prayers. Looking back over this past year I have an overwhelming sense of uncertainty that our current ministry programs are meeting the needs of our families. One thing that has been brought to my attention is we are living in a time that our children and youth programs may need to incorporate strategies to assist parents and help with PTSD in the post-Covid era. I have found that when we focus on relational connections by bringing the community together in fun family events — this form of ministry has proven to be a more effective outreach rather than the traditional modes of discipleship exclusively on Sunday mornings. This may mean an all-inclusive family ministry approach that will nurture and develop a foundation of faith in the family collectively. I am looking for people who would like to join me to brainstorm approaches and develop a clear strategy for a family ministry that would be most effective. It is my hope we can be in conversation and brainstorm ways we can meet the needs of our children, youth and families. Won't you join me to evaluate, strategize and implement programs going forward that will capture the hearts of our kids and respond to our ever-changing culture in our church and community?


