From the Pastor's heart,

As we move to the mid-way mark of 2022, it certainly has been an interesting 6 months! Our effort is focused on restoring as much normalcy as possible, while preparing for a future of growth, mission and becoming more like Jesus, everyday!

In this endeavor, I will be sharing a (5) week sermon series on the book, Five Practices of Fruitful Congregations, Revised and Updated by Bishop Robert Schnase, published in 2018 by Abingdon Press. This is the revision and updated version of his 2007 book which shared the same title. Schnase shares, *"Five Practices of Fruitful Congregations, Revised and Updated significantly expands the practices and the fruit we bear in communities everywhere. Now, those original "come to us" ideas are balanced with "go to them" initiatives. Strategies for doing things better are strengthened with ideas for doing things differently. "Doing ministry for" shifts to "doing ministry with". We learn how to welcome the guest and also how to become the guest among others. We see ways to create ministry inside and outside the walls of the church. This requires a different posture toward our neighborhoods, a deliberate outward focus, and a willingness to carry Christ's love to where people already live, work, and play, rather than hoping people will come to us. This is practical, nuanced, critically important work.*

The sermon series will be offered following this schedule:

June 5 – Radical Hospitality

June 12 – Passionate Worship

June 19- Intentional Faith Development

June 26 - Risk-Taking Mission

July 3 – Extravagant Generosity

Following the sermon series, it is my hope to organize 6-8 people into each practice to meet (1) time to discuss, discern and develop how we might strengthen and expand each practice. Please be praying about which group God might be calling you toward. As I have shared previously, please consider being a part of a group you have the "least" experience and expertise. Each group will also have its own facilitator.

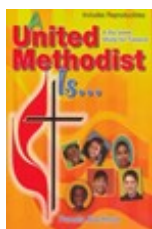


Sunday June 19th – Let's Celebrate
