Matthew 28:28-30

Jesus said, “Come to me, all you who are weary and carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.”

As a carpenter, Jesus likely made yokes. Yokes were made for two – not one. We were not meant to shoulder the load of life alone.

We may think that the symbol of the yoke is an added burden, when in actuality it frees us – if we’re wearing it correctly... It is made for two.
