SERMON NOTES

Who is Jesus?

6) Our King.

John 18:33-38a is a passage we normally hear during Holy Week. We in the United States don’t know much about kings. We may have watched King Charles’ coronation a couple of years ago, but that’s as close as we get.

When Pilate asked Jesus, “So you are a king?” Jesus answered, “For this I was born and for this I came into the world, to testify to the truth...” Maxie Dunnam suggests that that a simple “yes” from Jesus would have left a false impression. A “no” from Jesus would have been a denial of a deeper truth, for in the most real sense Jesus was, is, and will forever be – King.

Jesus doesn’t rule territories. He rules our hearts and souls. He rules with love and justice, not with terror and oppression like King Herod did when Jesus was born.

What does it look like for Jesus to be King of our lives? He is King if we pledge our ultimate allegiance to Him – with our mouth and with our lives.
