Who is Jesus?

#8: Our Servant

Last week we talked about Jesus our King. Aren't King and Servant opposites? In most of society - yes. For Jesus - no.

Washing one another's feet is not something we are accustomed to, but when Jesus walked this earth, it was common for a servant to wash his/her master's feet. Jesus was demonstrating servant leadership to his original disciples, and to us, His 21st Century disciples.

There's a meme on Facebook that says, "Sometimes I joke about what I'd do if I had one day left to live. Eat junk, go crazy, etc. Today it hit me: Jesus knew. And He washed feet. He. Washed. Feet." Let that sink in...

What does it mean for us to follow Jesus' example to be a servant to others? It doesn't mean to be a doormat for people to walk all over. It does mean to show strength and vulnerability at the same time, by putting others' needs before our own. We do, however, need to take care of ourselves or we will be no good for anyone else.

Symbolically, let us take up the basin and towel as Jesus did, and through sharing His love, be servants to those around us.
