Who is Jesus?

#10 Our Lord and Savior

Zacchaeus was a tax-collector – a Jew working for the Roman government, so it’s doubtful he had many friends.

Prior to meeting Jesus, *money* was Lord of Zacchaeus’ life. After meeting Jesus, *Jesus* was Lord of Zacchaeus’ life. Is that true for us as well? Is Jesus Lord of our lives? Have we surrendered complete allegiance to Him? If He is Lord of our lives, we will endeavor to live everyday for Him – in the way we interact with people, the way we use our money, the way we worship Him on a daily basis, etc.

Jesus is not just Lord – He is also our Savior. What do we need saving from? Our sins. We can accept the gift of salvation He offers, or we can reject it. By dying on the cross, He accomplished our forgiveness. He did for us what we cannot do for ourselves. *We are nowhere near perfect, but Jesus thinks we’re to die for!*
