SERMON NOTES

Matthew 1:18-25

Joseph never utters a word in Scripture, but he played a huge role in the birth of Jesus.

We can learn a lot from Joseph's faithfulness and example:

- Joseph's world was turned upside down when he found out Mary was pregnant. He didn't react immediately but responded after taking some time and listening to God. When our world is turned upside down, we may not be thinking straight. Thanks be to God that Joseph waited.
- He may have thought he had only 1 option, but God showed him another way not *out* of the situation, but *through* it. This should be instructive for us.
- Sometimes we may avoid doing the right thing because we're afraid of what others may think. Joseph did not succumb to this way of thinking. He was obedient to God. Are we willing to be obedient to God even if it means ridicule from those around us?
