**SERMON NOTES**

Matthew 3:13-17 – The Baptism of Jesus

John the Baptist called for repentance of sins, and baptism signaled the reorientation of a person's life toward God.

Why did Jesus come to John for baptism? He had no need to repent! He was sinless. Jesus' baptism was a way for Him to relate to us in our humanity, and along with His temptations in the wilderness, signaled the beginning of His earthly ministry.

Our baptism, is in essence, our call to ministry. Whether we took our own baptismal vows or they were made on our behalf, the promise is to follow Jesus as His disciple every day of our lives. Baptism does NOT make us a Christian, however. That is a decision we each need to make for ourselves.

Leonard Sweet: "Oh God, make a dead-end street at every turn that does not lead to you." What a wonderful prayer! Leonard Sweet also wrote: "Dead-ends are not endings. Dead-ends are the places where you turn around, about face, reconsider, re-adjust, and start again...The road back to Jesus is never out of range no matter how many wrong turns we've taken." That is certainly an example of God's amazing grace...Thanks be to God!
