CONFESSON OF SIN (in unison):

O God, You have shown us the way of life through Your son, Jesus Christ. We confess with shame our slowness to learn of Him, our failure to follow Him, and our reluctance to bear the cross. We confess the poverty of our worship, our neglect of fellowship and of the means of grace, our hesitating witness for Christ, our evasion of responsibilities in our service, and our imperfect stewardship of Your gifts.

(In silence, let each one of us make our personal confession to Almighty God).

Have mercy on me, O God, according to Your steadfast love; in Your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions. Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin. Create in me a clean heart, O God, and put a new and right spirit within me.

(From Psalm 51)

Now the message that we have heard from God's Son and announce is this: God is light, and there is no darkness at all in Him. If we live in the light – just as He is in the light – then we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, His Son, purifies us from every sin. If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and there is no truth in us. But if we confess our sins to God, He will keep His promise and do what is right; He will forgive us all our wrongdoing. (From John 1)
