SERMON NOTES

Matthew 5:7 – Blessed are the merciful, for they will receive mercy.”

Mercy is not a right and is not deserved, and yet our Lord shows us mercy abundantly. Lamentations 3:22-23 reminds us “*The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases, His mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness.*”

We have received mercy. How can we not show mercy to others?

The Rev. Dr. Ellsworth Kallas wrote: “We don’t need to know the specifics of someone’s need in order to be a messenger of mercy. Indeed, we may not even know that a need exists. But as we relate to a person in merciful kindness, the mercy finds its way directly to the place of pain.”

When we withhold mercy, we miss the blessing. Let us pray that showing mercy will not be a calculated behavior on our part, but rather a natural response of our discipleship.
