John 9:1-41

It was the prevailing belief at the time this story was written that if someone had a chronic infirmity or disability that it was the result of that person's sin or their parents' sin. Jesus says, NOT SO! What Jesus is saying is in essence, "Look what God can do through the circumstances of this man's life."

The transformation from blindness to physical sight *and* clear-eyed discipleship takes place for the man who was born blind. The Pharisees, though, were "blind" to the truth of who Jesus is.

Jesus can and desires to cure whatever spiritual blindness we are experiencing.

O say, can you see? Open our eyes, Lord, we want to see Jesus...
