Sermon Notes

Acts 2:1-21

Pentecost was not originally a Christian observance. It was originally celebrated as a spring harvest festival, 50 days after Passover. In the 1st Century, Pentecost was considered so important that all Jewish men within traveling distance (about 20 miles) were expected to be in Jerusalem for the festival. That's why there were so many people in Jerusalem that day who spoke different languages. When the Holy Spirit came upon the disciples, everyone gathered in Jerusalem heard the Good News of Jesus Christ in their own language – truly a miracle.

Too often, perhaps are unaware of or forget the power of the Holy Spirit that we have available to us.

Pentecost is a day for remembering where the church came from, how the church came to be, and for asking what on earth the church is for and where in *heaven's* name the church is headed.

Come, Holy Spirit!
Holy Spirit, You are welcome here!
