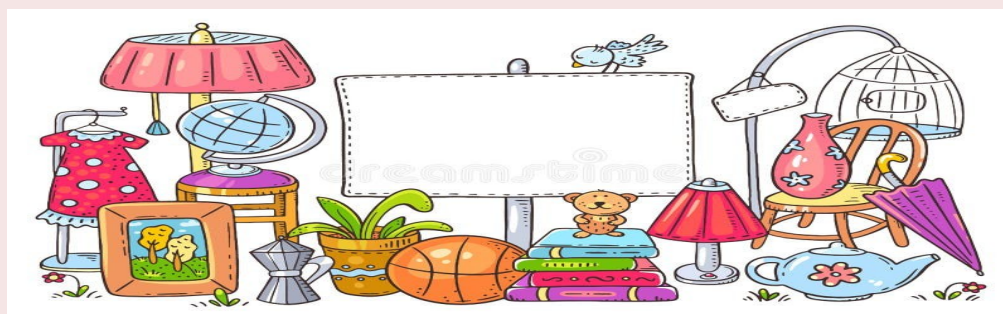

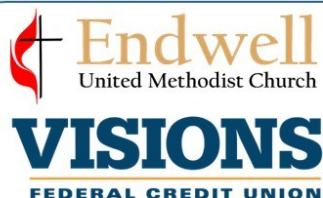

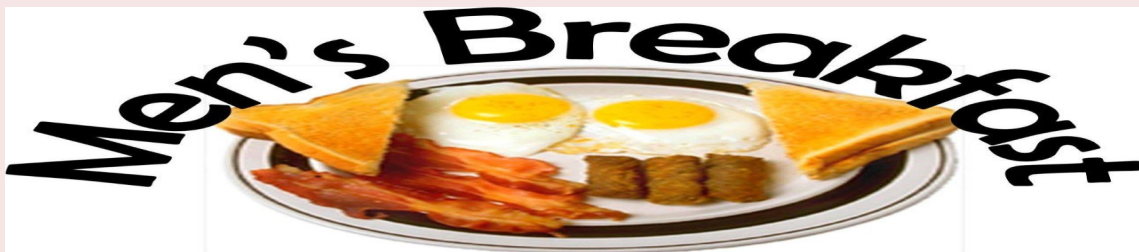
MOBILE FOOD PANTRY
